Our Direct Appeal continues to be underway. As a reminder, we are attempting to begin purchasing air conditioners for our children's classrooms.

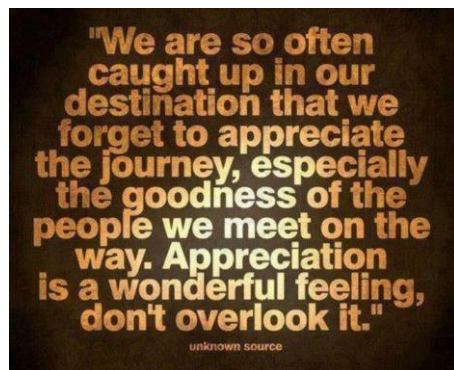
