

Thank you to all who gave coats to the coat drive. About 150 were donated! These went to families in our school community and the rest to the Covenant House residents in our community.


Also, thank you to Ms. Miller, the Eco Club, Zaida Cosme, and the Moore family for organizing this event and/or assisting with organizing the coats.
